

3. SETUP & INSTALLATION

- Refer to IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS for places to avoid
- Place the unit on dry, leveled surface
- Ventilation openings in the back of the unit must not be obstructed by objects or by wall.

3.1 PLAY ZONE

This machine requires space for playing and for maintenance as shown below.

Leave space around the game upon instalation:



3.2 CONNECTING POWER


IMPORTANT!

POWER SUPPLY ADJUSTS AUTOMATICALLY TO 115V OR 230V


- Machines electrical system (power supplies and display) will adjusts automatically to 230V or 115V voltage.
- Do not plug the equipment power cables into an electrical outlet if the power cable is damaged.
- Avoid putting many loads on one electrical outlet as it could generate heat the fire resulting from overload.



Connect the grounding conductor to the earth terminal (GND):



To disconnect the game, grip the plug and pul lit from the wall outlet. Never pull by the cord.



Ensure that nothing rests on the power cord and that it is not located where it can be stepped on or tripped over.



To prevent electric shock, do not touch the power plug when hand is wet.

4.1. SD CARD

The SD card contains audio sample files in MP3 format. There is one sound sample or each prize, and then some for pause, play and active (flash). Preferably, the MP3's should have a sample rate of 144kbps to 192kbps, but other rates may also function. If any of these files is missing at power-up, the display will show an error message.

Do NOT change the SD-card under power. Switch off first!

To access the micro-SD card, slide the silver cover approximately 1mm upwards until it hinges open. Install the micro-SD card exactly into the slots, keep it depressed there, then close the cover and slide it down. The micro-SD card must be formatted as FAT32, the most common format for these cards. FAT12, FAT16, NTFS, ExFAT and other formats are not supported. If necessary, reformat the disk on a Windows PC with a micro-SD slot or USB-interface, and force the PC to use FAT32 or use a special tool, e.g. from:

Cards with a capacity of 1 to 16GB (a.o. Lexar and Sandisk) have been successfully tested in the machine, and larger capacities should work as well. Note however that there may be cards for sale that do not work in embedded systems. It is strongly advised to first test a card before ordering a larger batch.



4.3 PLAYFIELD AND GAMEPLAY



- 1. Insert a coin and wait for the game to start
- 2. When the game starts, the player will hear the music assigned to the game mode, the START / STOP button will be illuminated and the bubbles on the playing field will light up one by one
- 3. The player's task is to press the START / STOP button when the bubble showing the ticket value that the player wants to win is highlighted
- 4. The player will receive the number of tickets shown on the illuminated bubble
- 5. If a player stops the game in the field labeled JACKPOT, he will be awarded the highest possible number of tickets for that field
- 6. If the player stops the game in the space labeled? MYSTERY VALUE, will receive a random number of tickets
- 7. If the player stops the game in the space labeled? 3 BONUS GAMES, will have the option to play 3 more games one after the other



5. GAME OPTIONS

5.1 MENU ACCESS AND NAVIGATION

To access menu press ENTER/SELECT button, located in service door, at the lower front of the machine, next to the coin and ticket counters.

Use UP/+ and DOWN/- buttons to navigate in the menu. Use ENTER/SELECT to ENTER or SELECT the option value or selection

REMEMBER THAT CHANGES IN THE SERVICE MENU CAN RELATE TO ELEMENTS SUCH AS THE COST OF THE GAME AND THE NUMBER OF WON TICKETS, AND WHICH MAY AFFECT THE EARNINGS OF THE DEVICE. MAKE SURE THAT THE CHANGES AND ENTERED VALUES ARE VALID.

6. MAINTENANCE, INSPECTION

6.1 SAFETY CHECK

Check the points listed before operating the machine. These checks are nessessary for safe machine operation:

- 1. Try to run the game before operation each day.
- 2. Conduct monthly routine checks of game components to ensure good working condition
- 3. Check the machine regularly for dust and clean when nesessary.

Note: Parts and components require preventative maintenance to be kept running smoothly

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Ticket dispensing is not working

- 1. Check Ticket settings in service menu and make sure that they are turned ON, and proper ticket dispenser is selected
- 2. Check ticket dispenser wiring and connections
- 3. Check ticket dispenser

Coin acceptor/bill acceptor is not working

- 1. Check Credit settings in serive menu and make sure that everything is set properly
- 2. Check coin/bill acceptor wiring and connections
- 3. Check coin/bill acceptor

No sound

- 1. Check Device settings in service menu
- 2. Check speakers wiring and connections

Plugged in and nothing happened

- 1. Check power wiring
- 2. Check power supplies placed behind front-central doors green LED light means OK
- 3. Check power supplies voltage-input settings. You need to chose between 115/230V before being operational. We set it to default voltage for country of machine destination.
- 4. Check main board or replace



8. TERMS OF WARRANTY

Magic Play Sp. z o.o. warrants that the LUCKY NUMBERS game will be free from electronical and mechanical defects for a period of 12 months from the date of delivery.

Warranty covers:

- Display
- CPU board
- I/O board
- Power supplies
- LED driver
- LED lighting

Warranty terms do not cover parts not included above.

Definition of defect:

It will be considered as defective if any connection between subcomponents on a particular board fails or any of them stops working itself. It does not include damages which occurred due to misuse, unauthorized connection or modifications.

Should the product prove defective during the warranty period, Magic Play, at its option, shall:

- 1. Repair the defective part by means of telephone support or depot service at no charge for parts of labor.
- 2. Replace the defective part with a comparable product which may be new or refurbished. Provided that
- 1. Magic Play is informed of the defect immediately after it occurred. The faulty part should be dispatched to Magic Play or its authorized distributor as soon as possible.
